SkillsFuture Credit



 To strengthen individual ownership of skills development and lifelong learning



- MySkillsFuture Courses
- Approved training providers



• Singaporeans aged 25 and above



- SingPass required
- Pay credit to training providers within 60 days before the course starts
- For Massive Online Open Courses
 (MOOC) 60 days before course starts
 or 90 days after course starts



- Opening Credit (\$500)
- One-off Credit Top-Up (\$500)
 - Courses from Institutes of Higher Learning (IHLs) and NTUC LearningHub eligible from
 1 Apr 2020
 - All SFC eligible courses from 1 Oct 2020
- Additional Credit for Mid-Career Support (\$500) from 1 Oct 2020

PLAN

Plan your learning and use your available credit to pick up new skills to improve your employability and for lifelong learning.



RESEARCH

Do your proper research to find out more about training providers. Check out what others are saying about the courses you are interested in.

Watch out for errant training providers.



PROTECT

Only reveal personal information when you are signing up for the course.

password are
confidential. Do not share
it with others. Training
providers are not allowed
to take your SingPass
details to apply for use of
your Credit.



USE of SFC

Use your SFC to defray your training costs.

Your SFC cannot be transferred to other users.

It cannot be used for other purposes like exchanging for cash or vouchers or gifts.
